

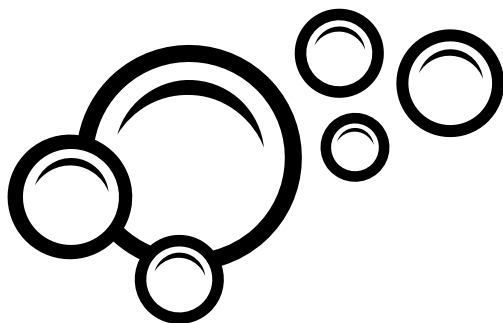
Creative Bubbles

Bubbles are fun! Use your creativity to design your own bubble wand.



Materials

- Bubble solution
- Chenille stems
- Solution container (like a storage container from home)



Procedure

- Bend one end of the chenille stem into a circle. (Make your circle slightly smaller than the container.)
- Wrap the stem of the circle around the longer stem, so it looks like a lollipop.
- Bend the long stem so that it stands up (perpendicular) to the circle.



Activities

- Pour bubble solution into the container and dip the circle in the solution.
- Gently blow on the solution film that forms inside the circle to make a bubble.
- Repeat this process using other shapes, like a star, triangle, square or any shape you like. Do some shapes work better than others?



Observations

- What shape that makes the most bubbles?
- What shape makes the biggest bubbles?
- What shape makes the most oddly shaped bubbles?
